- d) To establish facilities in the state to provide early intervention services to children with IDD.
- e) To do and undertake the task of educational and vocational upliftment of the Sector.
- f) To provide avenues for children with IDD to earn their livelihood.








(2) In furtherance of the above objective the NGO will be at liberty:-

- (vi) To organize and participate in seminars, conferences, fairs related to the objects of the Organization and to compile, collate, edit and publish technical reports and papers related to the objects of the Society.
- (vii) To raise funds for the group's activities.
- (viii) To pay all expenses, preliminary or incidental to the formation of the Society and its registration.
- (ix) To run educational institutions, training institutions and publish books, reports journals, magazines, newspapers, periodicals, thesis, researches, writings, discoveries, documents, news and information.
